



2019 TEAM SUPPORT RULES

1. One team support person from each team must attend all team support meetings called by an SCP Board Member, so that important information may be passed along to your team.
2. One team support person must attend all team practices, games and/or functions.
3. Team support is to keep anyone involved with their team informed of all team and league activities. It is requested that this be done a minimum of once a week through a newsletter/email so that everyone is well informed. The SI Play app is a great tool for team communication.
4. Ensure that the team roster is kept up to date in SI Play (names and contact info). If you find that information is inaccurate or incomplete, please notify the Registration Coordinator so that it may be corrected.
5. Encourage and require participation from all athletes, in all league fundraisers. Fundraising money and paperwork must be turned in on set dates along with any unsold fundraising items to our Community Activities Coordinator or other SCP Board Member.
6. Provide a receipt to everyone – cash, check, credit card!! Keep a record of all monies collected from your team and also receipts for everything that the money is used for. A receipt book is provided for each team and it is required to be turned in at the end of the season with a detailed earning/expenses for the team.
7. Take attendance at all practices and games. Inform parents if multiple practices are missed, it will affect the athletes participation in that week's game.
8. Complete a "Record of Injury Form" immediately if anyone (athlete, volunteer, sibling or parent) is injured. Return the form to the Team Support Coordinator.
9. All functions are solely for the benefit of the children. Please remind parents of this on a regular basis. Always be supportive and strive to motivate parents and children to have fun and remain positive no matter what. Promote good sportsmanship from all involved.
10. Only athletes, badged volunteers and game officials are allowed on the game/practice field or sidelines. All spectators will remain in the designated viewing areas. Persons who interfere with our activities may be removed by law enforcement.
11. All team support volunteers must participate in all league functions. Team support should encourage participation in all pre-season, regular season, and post season activities, including kick-off classic, jamborees, bowl games, playoffs, championship games and competitions.
